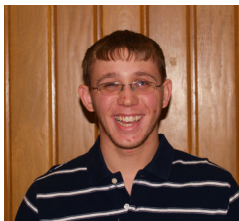


**COLORADO CONSERVATION TILLAGE ASSOCIATION
